properly licensed.**

All dogs must be licensed when you buy or adopt them (earliest is 8 weeks old) or 3 months of age, whichever comes first, by Jan. 1 of each year.



*Failure to have your dog licensed may result in a fine of up to \$500 plus court costs.*

Annual Licenses ..... \$10.80  
Lifetime Licenses ..... \$52.80

**Senior Citizens or Residents with Disabilities:**

Annual Licenses ..... \$8.80  
Lifetime Licenses ..... \$36.80
